


## LCOO Overview

- Weekly video meeting conferences since early August 2016



<ul> <li>The members reviewed and tentatively agreed upon a draft charter (additional minor modification expected)</li> <li>Registering as a formal OpenStack "Working Group" is in Progress</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Minimum Criteria:</li> <li>Be a large Operator and/or Network Service Provider</li> <li>Participate equally with other members in the meetings and other activities of LCOO</li> <li>Be a contributor to the OpenStack platform with at least 4 dedicated FTE's contributing</li> <li>Contribute a minimum of 2 FTE's to upstream activities aligned to the LCOO roadmap</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>OpenStack Community Contributors with a Shared Interest In:</li> <li>Accelerating the enterprise maturity and adoption of OpenStack</li> <li>Driving Community awareness of platform enhancements necessary to address the unique use cases of network service providers and horizontally scaling, massively distributed, cloud operators.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Align with the OpenStack Foundation:</li> <li>Work openly and transparently within established channels</li> <li>Communicate Roadmap through Enterprise, Product, and Operator Working groups</li> <li>Engages with the OpenStack Foundation Board, Technical Committee and User Committee to drive coordination across projects</li> <li>Works with certain groups outside of OpenStack such as OPNFV whose work has critical impacts on the platform</li> </ul>

- Engage more broadly and effectively within the community to raise awareness and accelerate • improvement.

- Meets monthly to re-align on Strategy execution, review progress and (re)direct activities as needed
